

Elk Grove Township Board Accepting Applications to Fill Vacant Trustee Position

Elk Grove Township – On Monday February 26, 2018 the Elk Grove Township Board of Trustees formerly accepted the letter of resignation from senior Trustee Andrea Koshaba from her position as Elk Grove Township Trustee. Trustee Koshaba stated in her letter that she was stepping down due to health, work and family issues.

“Andrea has served the residents of Elk Grove Township very well for over a decade. She brought a wealth of knowledge and enthusiasm to the job and her advice and counsel, especially in financial matters, will be missed,” stated Township Clerk George Busse. Trustee Suellen Satern praised Koshaba’s service to Elk Grove Township and stated she will be difficult to replace.

The Board of Trustees must now fill the Trustee vacancy and the board members are opening the process to the residents of Elk Grove Township. Individuals who are interested in filling the Trustee vacancy are asked to provide their name, address and a letter of interest with a short resume by the close of business (4:00 p.m.) on Friday, March 23, 2018. Applicants should plan to be available to speak with the Township Board sometime after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 2, 2018.

In accordance with State Statutes any person appointed to fill this vacancy shall be a member of the same political party as the person vacating the office; in this case the Republican Party. The appointee shall establish his or her political party affiliation by his or her record of voting in Republican Party primary elections or by holding or having held an office in a Republican Party organization before appointment. If the appointee has not voted in a Republican primary election or is not holding or has not held an office in a Republican Party organization before the appointment, then the appointee shall establish his or her Republican Party affiliation by his or her record of participating in the Republican Party’s nomination or election caucus.
