Tax bill return service

To help homeowners who have mail-delivery problems, the Cook County Treasurer's Office has started a new online service that shows when tax bills have been returned by the U.S. Postal Service. Property owners who don't receive their tax bills may face interest charges for late payments and even see their properties go up for sale for delinquent taxes. - Enter your address or Property Index Number (PIN)
- Look for a red warning box that pops up if your bill has been returned
- Update your mailing information if it is incorrect
- Choose "e-Billing" if you wish to receive your bill by email



Does Illinois owe you money?

Unclaimed money or property in Illinois that may belong to you can be found on the Illinois Treasurer's office website. Residents can enter their name or business address to check for unclaimed property or the status of a claim already filed. The State Treasurer is holding \$2.9 billion dollars in unclaimed funds for Illinoisans. [Click here to start the process.](#)
